CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, J. K. Durst and John B. Sloan, both of Greenwood, S. C.

did on the 25th day of November 1921 file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is

-----GENERAL TRUST COMPANY-----

THIRD: That the principal place of business is

Greenwood, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy and sell real estate; negotiate loans on real and personal property; buy and sell stock in other corporations, and own stock in other corporations by purchase or as an original subscriber thereto; write fire and life insurance; finance other corporations as fiscal agent, or otherwise; and, in general, to carry on the usual business incident to a trust company.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is
Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars,
payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Five Hundred (500)
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the
day of
1921, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: J. K. Durst, J. K. Self and John B. Sloan.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, John B. Sloan;
as Vice-President, J. K. Durst; as Secretary, M. W. Turner;
as Treasurer, John B. Sloan.

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter XLVII, Article I, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1912, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Index-Journal, a newspaper published in the County of Greenwood.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. BANKS DOVE, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mease Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
