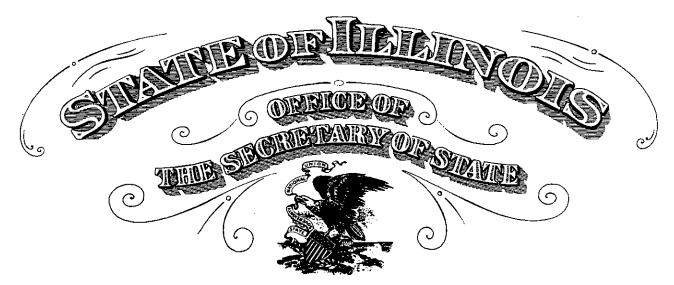

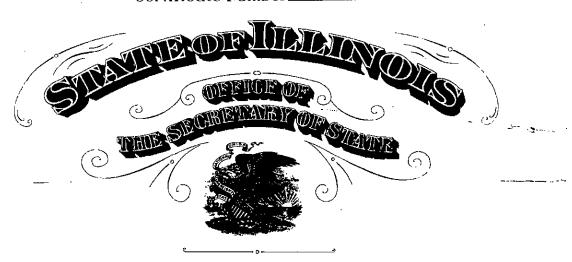

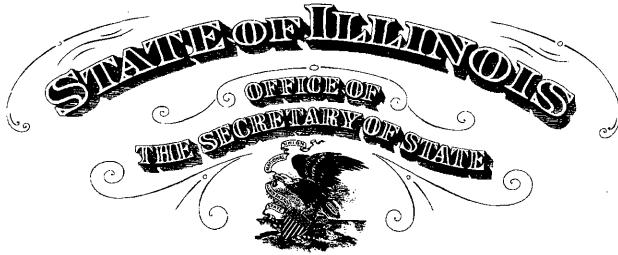

Pursuant to Section 110.30 of the Illinois General Not for Profit Corporation Act of 1986, the Articles of Incorporation of Youth Guidance, an Illinois Not for Profit Corporation (the "Corporation"), which was originally incorporated under the name The Church Mission of Help of the Diocese of Chicago on March 26, 1924, which subsequently changed its name to Youth Guidance, pursuant to an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, effective May 28, 1954, are hereby amended and restated in their entirety. The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of Youth Guidance shall henceforth be as follows:

### ARTICLE 1: CORPORATE NAME

The name of the Corporation is Youth Guidance.

### ARTICLE 2: REGISTERED AGENT

The registered agent of the Corporation shall be Vivian Loseth. The registered office of the Corporation shall be 122 S. Michigan Avenue, Suite No. 1510, Chicago, Illinois 60603.

### **ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE**

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. federal tax law, including but not limited to the following:

- (a) undertaking charitable and educational missions, activities, and programs as the Board or other Committee may from time to time determine; and
- (b) any other charitable or educational purposes and activities for which corporations may be organized and operated under the State of Illinois General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986, as amended (the "Act"), subject to the requirements and restrictions of Code Section 501(c)(3) and other relevant provisions of federal, state and local laws.

### **ARTICLE 4: DURATION**

The Corporation shall have perpetual duration unless and until dissolved in accordance with the provisions set forth in the bylaws.
