**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
IR SUPPLY LLC**

The undersigned, desiring to form a limited liability company under the provisions of the Virginia Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 12 of Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended (the "Act"), hereby sets forth the following:

1. **Name.** The name of the limited liability company is IR Supply LLC (the "Company").

2. **Registered Office and Agent.** The post office address of the initial registered office of the Company is located in the City of Richmond, Virginia, at 2100 East Cary Street, Richmond, Virginia 23223. The initial registered agent is Roderick W. Simmons; Esquire, who is a resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia, a member of the Virginia State Bar, and whose business address is the same as the post office address of the initial registered office.


3. **Principal Office.** The post office address of the principal office where the Company's records will be maintained is 2200 Magnolia Street, Richmond, Virginia 23223.

4. **Elimination of Liability for Monetary Damages.** In any proceeding brought by or in the right of the Company or brought by or on behalf of its members, no manager or member will be liable to the Company or its members for any monetary damages with respect to any transaction, occurrence, course of conduct, or otherwise, except for liability resulting from such manager's or member's having engaged in willful misconduct or a knowing violation of the criminal law or any Federal or state securities laws, or except as otherwise agreed in writing.

5. **Indemnification.** Except as otherwise limited by applicable law, the Company shall indemnify each of its managers and members (including advancing and reimbursing expenses) if such manager or member is made a party to a proceeding, whether such manager or member is serving the Company or, at its request, any other entity, to the extent such member or manager conducted himself in a manner consistent with the indemnification of corporate officers and directors under Section 13.1-697 (A) and (B) of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as may be amended or superseded from time to time.

6. **Determination for Indemnification.** Any indemnification under Section 5 (unless otherwise ordered by a court) will be made by the Company only as authorized in the specific case upon a determination that indemnification is proper in the circumstances because the applicable standard of conduct has been met. The determination must be made in accordance with Section 13.1-701 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as may be amended or superseded from time to time.
